## Waste code

**W.RW.S-00004**

### Composition

- ✓ Combustible Residual Waste from production facilities or offices, shops and services.
- ✓ Size; fits in household waste bags or containers of no more than 240 litres - **maximum 30 x 30 x 100 cm**
- ✓ Nature and composition comparable to household waste.

### Other conditions

Calorific value	8-12 MJ/kg
Total chlorine	< 1 %
Total sulphur	< 0.5 %

<u>Composition waste materials</u>	Maximum allowed.
Paper/cardboard (not pressed)	30 %
Plastics	25 %
Wood	15 %
Organic waste	25 %
Textiles, leather, carpet (not pressed)	20 %

<u>Residue (total &lt; 20%)</u>	Maximum allowed.
Metals	10 %
Glass	10 %
Sand, soil	15 %

### Occasional, a maximum of 2% volume of the total:

Rubble, plaster, insulation material (glass wool, rock wool, polystyrene).

### Excluded

- ✗ Asbestos (or similar material)
- ✗ Asphalt and roofing
- ✗ Tires
- ✗ Batteries and accumulators
- ✗ Chemical waste; such as liquids and jerry cans
- ✗ Pressure containers; Nitrous oxide cylinders/aerosol cans/gas bottles
- ✗ Electronic appliances/White and brown goods/Electronics
- ✗ Bulky residual waste; >30x30x100 cm
- ✗ Carcasses or parts thereof; faeces, fish waste, meat waste, offal
- ✗ Solid rolls with a diameter of 15 cm or larger
- ✗ Solid metal pieces or bars
- ✗ Mattresses
- ✗ PVC
- ✗ Radioactive waste
- ✗ Stringy material longer than 1 metre; cables, ropes, nets, sails, foil rolls, etc.
- ✗ Highly odorous waste
- ✗ Highly dusty substances such as powders and sawdust
- ✗ Fireworks and explosives
- ✗ Hospital waste

- ✗ Hazardous waste;
- ✗ Substances with one of the following hazard labels:



Deviating waste materials or compositions must be requested separately.
